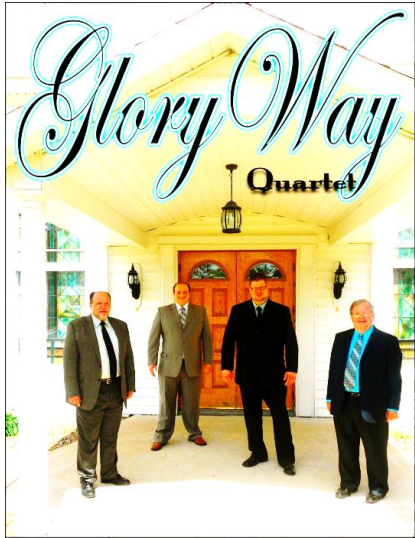

What You Need to Know ...

There are guest rooms, RV sites, a tent camping area and nearby motels of several brands.

LODGING: Dorm rooms \$40/day (Plus \$85 room deposit, paid in advance)

RV sites with electric \$20/day. Tent spaces \$10/day w/electric & \$5/day w/out.
